Deliverables include the following type of work, but not limited to:

Types of services include but are not limited to

Produce foundation reports and LOTBs for structures including bridges, earth retaining structures, signs, and buildings.

Produce geotechnical reports for roadway and geotechnical related Standard Plan design portions of projects.

Prepare Site Investigation Plans needed to perform the site investigation.

#### Scope of Services Continued

Deliverables include the following type of work, but not limited to: Perform site investigations to obtain data for geotechnical recommendations. There will be both non-hazardous and hazardous sites. The site investigation will include, but limited to:

Geotechnical Drilling: Consultant shall be capable of providing drill rigs and support equipment for mud rotary, punch core, rock coring, hollow-stem auger, and solid-stem auger. The Consultant shall be able to provide drill rigs capable of horizontal drilling, all terrain drill rig, and limited access drill rig when required. The rig shall be equipped with various samplers that include Standard Penetration Test (SPT), modified California samplers, and Shelby tubes. Consultant shall be able to install/destroy geotechnical instrumentation including piezometers, slope inclinometers, and time domain reflectometry (TDR) cables.

Cone Penetrometer Test (CPT): Consultant shall provide a CPT rig. The CPT rig shall be capable of using the piezocone and seismic cone.

#### Scope of Services continued

Deliverables include the following type of work, but not limited to:

The Consultant Task Order Manager must:

Provide a geologist or engineer to perform the field logging with the drilling operation.

Consultant shall be capable of performing downhole and surface geophysical studies.

Perform laboratory testing and reporting on soil and rock.

Provide final drafting of Log of Test Borings and Boring Records produced for each borehole and CPT hole.

Provide support of the site investigation that may include traffic control, construct access roads, use of a barge, and helicopter for difficult access sites.

#### Scope of Services continued

Deliverables include the following type of work, but not limited to:

Provide construction support for geotechnical aspects of a project. This may include responding to Bidders Inquires during the bidding, Request For Information (RFI) during the construction, and supporting the Caltrans construction staff during construction.

Provide support to Caltrans Construction to Notice of Potential Claims (NOPC) and Contractor's Claims.

The Consultant's personnel shall be capable, competent, and experienced in performing the types of work in this Contract with minimal instruction.

Personnel skill level should match the specific job classification and task complexity. The Consultant's personnel shall be knowledgeable about, and comply with, all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws and regulations.

#### **Consultant Contract Manager**

The Consultant Contract Manager must coordinate work-related matters and consultant's operations under this contract with the Caltrans Contract Manager in coordination with the Caltrans Task Order Manager.

The Consultant Contract Manager must have a minimum of five (5) years of responsible experience performing the duties as a contract manager for similar geotechnical engineering services contracts. The Consultant Contract Manager must be knowledgeable about all Caltrans policies and procedures. The Consultant Contract Manager must be always accessible to Caltrans. The Consultant Contract Manager must be an employee of the prime consultant.

The Consultant Contract Manager must be a registered professional engineer licensed in the State of California in good standing with the California State Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists always during the contract period, to perform the tasks described in this contract and in the Task Orders and must have a documented minimum ten (10) years of demonstrated experience acceptable to Caltrans.

Consultant Contract Manager must be responsible for all matters related to the consultant's personnel, subconsultants, geotechnical engineering work, and consultant's and subconsultants' operations as outlined in the Contract Statement of Work (SOW).

Engineer and Geologist

All Geotechnical Reports produced by the Consultant shall be signed by a California licensed Civil Engineer (PE) or a California licensed Geotechnical Engineer (GE) and a California licensed Professional Geologist (PG) or a Certified Engineering Geologist (CEG) with at least five (5) years experience in the field of expertise related to the report subject matter.

The Consultant Engineer and Geologist must be a registered professional licensed in the State of California in good standing with the California State Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists at all times while assigned to work on this contract and in the Task Orders.

#### Consultant Task Order Manager

The Consultant Task Order Manager must have a minimum of five (5) years of responsible experience performing the duties as a contract manager. The Consultant Task Order Manager must be a registered professional engineer licensed in the State of California in good standing with the California State Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, and Geologists at all times during the contract period, to perform the tasks described in this contract and in the Task Orders and must have a documented minimum ten (10) years of demonstrated experience acceptable to Caltrans.

The Consultant Task Order Manager must be accessible to the Caltrans Contract Manager in coordination with the Caltrans Task Order Manager at all times during normal Caltrans working hours that Task Order work is underway.

#### Consultant Task Order Lead Person

The Consultant Task Order Lead person (who may not be the Consultant Contract Manager) must be assigned to conduct, or direct the conduct of, all work assigned under a single Task Order. The Consultant Task Order Lead person must be the primary contact for the assigned Task Order and be available as needed for communication with Caltrans.
