The Consultant is required to provide professional and technical engineering staff who can perform structure construction inspection services.

Structure construction inspection services will range from structure representative level tasks in the office down to technician tasks in the field.

The Structure Representative, Assistant Structure Representatives and Transportation Engineering Technician may be Caltrans or Consultant employees.

Consultant Contract Manager

Have a minimum of five (5) years of responsible experience performing the duties as a contract manager for similar construction inspection services contracts.

Must be accessible to Caltrans at all times.

Be an employee of the prime consultant.

Be a registered professional engineer licensed in the State of California and a minimum ten (10) years of demonstrated experience acceptable to Caltrans.

Be responsible for all matters related to the consultant's personnel, subconsultants, structures construction inspection services work, and consultant's and subconsultants' operations as outlined in the Contract Statement of Work (SOW).

Manage budgets at the Project Level

Consultant Task Order Manager

The Consultant Task Order Manager must:

Have a minimum of five (5) years of responsible experience performing the duties as a Task Order Manager.

Be a registered professional engineer licensed in the State of California and must have a documented minimum ten (10) years of demonstrated experience acceptable to Caltrans.

Be always accessible to the Caltrans Contract Manager and the Caltrans Task Order Manager during normal Caltrans working hours that Task Order work is underway.

Structure Representative

The Consultant Structure Representative must:

Have a minimum of two (2) years of responsible experience performing the duties as a Structure Representative for similar construction inspection projects.

Be a registered professional engineer licensed in the State of California.

The Calmentor Program is consistent with the Governor's Executive Order No. S-11-06 to encourage new businesses, grow existing businesses, and promote small and emerging business contracting with the State of California.

Calmentor supports the participation of certified Small Business Enterprise (SBE), Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE), and Disabled Veterans Business Enterprises (DVBE) firms in the Central Region.
