About LCTOP

LCTOP is one of several programs established by Senate Bill 862, approved by the California Legislature in 2014. These workshops will discuss the changes to LCTOP that will be necessary if bills passed by the Legislature are signed by the Governor. Specifically, SB 824 would streamline project eligibility, project audits, funding for operational projects, and provide an option for a Letter of No Prejudice. AB 1550 would change requirements related to disadvantaged communities.

LCTOP FY 16-17 allocation estimates will be provided later this fiscal year, after additional Cap and Trade auctions occur.
