The <u>Base Route</u>, named Aero Shuttle to Lake County-Sacramento posted schedule is shown in (figure 2). Sacramento fixed scheduled shuttle stops are listed along the top of each timetable column in Figure 2. The bottom of the chart indicates the times and stop locations in the downtown Sacramento area. The time schedule also shows that Aero Shuttle to Lake County – Sacramento, the <u>Base Route</u> operates from 5:00am until 8:55pm. Local and Regional transit connections to Lake County are available until Lake County Transit- 3:05pm, Amtrak -5:00pm, Regional Transit- 5:10pm, Greyhound- 5:20pm and the Sacramento International Airport at 6:00pm.

The <u>Base Route</u> has four direct connections with Lake County Transit lines; for, Aero Shuttle uses (LCT) bus stops in Middletown, Kelseyville, Clearlake and Clearlake Oaks. Aero Shuttle has direct meaningful connections with Lake County Transit buses; Route 1—North Shore Clearlake to Lakeport, Route 2—South county to Cobb, Route 3-St. Helena/Santa Rosa, Route 4a-South Shore Clearlake to Lakeport via Soda Bay. Route 5- Clearlake City North Loop and Route 6- Clearlake City South Loop. These routes serve the City of Clearlake and other urban areas and rural communities situated around Lake County and connects services (via directly or indirectly) both the north and south ends of the lake. Moreover, indirect connections are available to Route 7- Lake County- Ukiah route, which in turn gives passengers access to Ukiah and Sonoma Counties. Conversely, Lake County Transit buses will now allow residents in urban areas and rural communities to have access to local and regional transit connections by connecting with Aero Shuttle's <u>Base Route</u> to Sacramento. This connection will allow riders to travel form Mendocino and Sonoma Counties to Sacramento County with just one transfer.
