The City does not anticipate being ready to allocate Construction funding this calendar year due to the delay in the ROW phase being completed, which is driven by the funding shortfall. The City therefore asked for a time extension to allocate Construction funding at the June 2023 CTC Meeting. The duration of the time extension request was 24 months, but a 4 month extension was approved, which takes the current Construction allocation date to October 31, 2023.

There was a delay in obtaining the environmental permits for construction, resulting in an overall delay of the completion of the PS&E phase of the project. Construction start date has been pushed out to accommodate the delay in completion of the PS&E phase and allow time to award a construction contract. 9 month Time Extension to Award is being requested at the August 2023 CTC Meeting. New deadline to award will be June 30, 2024.
