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ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

1. Permit expires on December 31st, 2022 or upon written notice from Caltrans of revocation of the permit.
2. A misdemeanor violation of 35784 CVC exists when all required accompaniments, provisions or conditions are not met.
3. Permit is only valid on State Highway System excluding restricted bridges listed. The permittee shall reimburse Caltrans for all costs and expenses incurred by Caltrans to conduct inspections of facilities, roadways, structures, and/ or appurtenances as a result of non-compliance with this condition.
4. The permittee is responsible for securing the intermodal shipping container on the trailer and reviewing the routes to ensure no conflicts with any laws, regulations, or ordinances exist while transporting products.
5. The permittee can carry the permit and accompaniments in electronic or paper form. The permittee will provide a 30-day report (Route Information Log) providing the origin location, destination location and the route that was taken from origin to destination. This spreadsheet log must be submitted within 5 days of the 30-day period.
6. Non-compliance with any terms or conditions of this or any previously issued Transportation Permit authorizing excess weight loads will result in revocation of the permit and/ or denial of an application for such permit.
7. Permit is not valid on County/ City Roads. Carrier must contact County or City jurisdictions for local permits.
8. The permittee is responsible for all liability for injury to, or death of person, or damage to property which may occur through any act or omission of either the permittee or the State of California arising from the issuance of this permit. In the event of any claim, suit, or action is brought against the State of California, its officers, employees, or agents from such claim, suit, or action, including all costs, expenses, and fees incurred by the State of California.

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ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS (Continued):

9. In accepting this permit, the permittee agrees to repair at their own expense and to the satisfaction of Caltrans, any damages to highway appurtenances or structures resulting from travel under this permit. Notwithstanding, work or repair may be conducted or performed by Caltrans at the option of the Director of Caltrans, the cost to be borne by the permittee. The permittee shall also be responsible for and reimburse Caltrans for all costs and expenses incurred by Caltrans to inspect the damage and/ or repairs to the appurtenances or structures, whether or not Caltrans opts to conduct or perform the work or repair. In the event of damage to State highway facilities such as bridges, traffic signals, light standards, and other appurtenances, a written report must be filed with Caltrans within 72 hours after such damage has been done. Failure to make this report will be considered cause for revocation of the permit pending a satisfactory arrangement with Caltrans for repair or replacement of the damaged facility.

10. This permit is valid for transporting intermodal shipping containers with international commerce only. If the container is found to have non-international commerce, the applicable permit shall be revoked immediately, and the container will have to be reduced in weight until it complies with legal weight standards. When this has been accomplished the transportation of the container may continue.

11. Provide the route in detail avoiding all restricted bridges attached. Use a separate sheet if you need additional space.
