Compressed gas containers, cylinders and tanks shall be secured to prevent falling caused by contact, vibration or seismic activity. Securing of compressed gas containers, cylinders and tanks shall be by one of the following methods:

1. Securing containers, cylinders and tanks to a fixed object with one or more restraints.

- 2.Securing containers, cylinders and tanks on a cart or other mobile device designed for the movement of compressed gas containers, cylinders or tanks.
- 3.Nesting of compressed gas containers, cylinders and tanks at container filling or servicing facilities or in sellers' warehouses not open to the public. Nesting shall be allowed provided that the nested containers, cylinders or tanks, if dislodged, do not obstruct the required means of egress.
- 4. Securing of compressed gas containers, cylinders and tanks to or within a rack, framework, cabinet or similar assembly designed for such use.

Exception: Compressed gas containers, cylinders and tanks in the process of examination, filling, transport or servicing.

Comment: All compressed cylinders and tanks shall be secured in an appropriate manner at all times.

Upon disruption or diminishment of the fire protective qualities of such equipment, material or systems, immediate action shall be instituted to effect a reestablishment of such equipment material or systems to their original normal and operational condition.

Provide successful service documentation from a state license service provider for the following systems:

- -Fire Sprinkler System (Wet Pipe) Annual & 5 Year on state AES forms.
- -Standpipe System (*If applicable) Annual & 5 Year on state AES forms.
- -Private Fire Hydrants Annual & 5 Year on state AES forms.
- -Fire Alarm NFPA72 Annual Testing and Maintenace form.
- -Exit sign & emergency lighting annual 90-minute testing documentation.
