



As Tammy discussed earlier, we are here, in the yellow box, but following this meeting, Caltrans and its partners will look to finalize the Purpose and Need statement and then focus on developing alternatives and screening them through the rest of 2021.

We currently anticipate the next public meeting to occur in late fall with a final PEL Study complete by Summer of 2022.
