Subject: **PROJECT LIST FOR ALLOCATION OF THE FEDERAL CORONAVIRUS
RESPONSE AND RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 2021 –
CRRSAA PROGRAM FUNDS, RESOLUTION CRSA-A-2122-02**

ISSUE:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the Project List for the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA) in accordance with the program guidelines?

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the Commission approve the Project List for the CRRSAA Program. The CRRSAA Program guidelines require regions to submit a project list for allocation by the Commission prior to the obligation of funds. Approval of this Project List will allow 16 local agencies to seek obligation of project funds for the 21 projects listed in Attachment A.

BACKGROUND:

The Federal Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA) apportioned \$911.8 million to California. Under CRRSAA, the COVID Relief Funds may be used for a broad range of surface transportation purposes listed in Section 113(b) of Title 23 of the U.S. Code and are meant to “prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus.” Specifically, CRRSAA allows states to cover revenue losses, which is important given that California’s state-generated transportation revenues have declined by about \$1.5 billion due to the pandemic. Additionally, CRRSAA allows COVID Relief Funds to be used for preventive and routine maintenance, operations, personnel, salaries, contracts,

debt service payments, availability payments, as well as transfers to public tolling agencies.

At the March 2021 Commission meeting, the Commission approved the COVID Relief funding distribution and regional apportionments for the CRRSAA Program. A total of \$182.4 million will be distributed to the regions from the CRRSAA Program.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Be it Resolved, the Commission approves the Project List submitted for CRRSAA Program funding, as presented in Attachment A.

The Department is authorized to sub-allocate these funds in accordance with their subvention policies and procedures.
